**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store in a cool, dry area away from children. Do not store or transport at temperatures below 32° F. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. Do not reuse container. Container Disposal: Use product until container is empty. Offer for recycling if possible. Recycling is not available or if the container is not empty, wrap the container in several layers of paper and discard in the trash.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Read entire label before each use.

This product is intended to be used in and around residences and their immediate surroundings such as (but not limited to): apartments, atriiums, attics, basements, bedrooms, bathrooms, boats, cabins, campers, carparks, cat sleeping quarters, clothes storage, condominiums, decks, driveways, garages, garages, homes, kitchens, lanais, living rooms, porches, patios, pet sleeping areas, play rooms, porches, rooms, solariums, storage areas, sun rooms, utility rooms and verandas. Do not use in commercial food handling establishments, restaurants or other places where food is commercially prepared or processed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets and plants from areas to be treated and cover fish aquaria. Do not use this product on humans. Do not use on household pets or domestic animals. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry. For product information call (800) - 238-2998. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only as a spot and crack and crevice treatment. Do not spray on wallpaper or let material run down painted walls. Spray until surface is slightly moist. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feet should be covered or removed.

**Cockroaches:** Remove all dishes, food and utensils from the area to be sprayed. Use a flashlight to illuminate dark areas. Make spot applications to infested roach routes - under and behind sinks, into cracks and crevices, along baseboards, behind and under stoves and refrigerators, into pipeholes in walls, and into cracks of kitchen cupboards. Inspect and treat other areas in the house where infestation is evident. Pay particular attention to bathrooms, cracks and crevices in closets, door frames, dresser drawers and frames. Cockroaches driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Replace dishes, food, and utensils only after shelves and baseboards have thoroughly dried.

**Booklice, boxelder bugs, centipedes, clover mites, crickets, dermestids, elm leaf beetles, firebrats, ground beetles, palmetto bugs, scorpions, silverfish, spiders, sowbugs, pillbugs, and waterbugs:** Apply as a spot and crack & crevice treatment to areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in hidden areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases, and similar areas. Cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

**Ants:** Spray around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter the house.  
**Carpenter Ants:** For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Spray into infested wood through existing openings.

**Fleas (adults and larvae):** Preparation: Remove pets from rooms to be treated. Vacuum floors, carpeting, and upholstered furniture in rooms where infestation is evident. Pay particular attention to areas where pets sleep, eat, and rest. Discard contents of vacuum bag. Wash and clean linoleum and tile floors before treatment. DO NOT treat pets with this product. For best results, treat your pet with a product registered for use on pets and domestic animals before allowing them to return to treated area. Treatment: Treat the entire infested areas of floor and floor covering. Do not soak or saturate floors or other surfaces. Treat other infested areas such as pet beds/bedding, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, on and under small area rugs, and along and behind baseboards. Delicate fabrics should be tested for staining in an inconspicuous area prior to use. After the treatment: Replace pet bedding with fresh materials once spray has dried. Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until all surfaces are thoroughly dry. When weather permits open windows to allow fresh air to circulate through treated areas. Make sure floors, carpeting, and all surfaces are thoroughly dry before reoccupying the room.

**Ticks:** Ticks which may carry Lyme Disease (Adults and larvae): Follow the same preparation and treatment directions for fleas. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices in rooms where pets eat, sleep, and rest. Use a fine pin stream and alcohol to remove ticks from pets, children or food. Plants can be returned to original location when leaves dry. If plants cannot be moved, cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Avoid spraying surrounding areas. Apply spray to upper and lower surfaces of foliage. Avoid wetting blossoms if possible.

**Pantry Pests - Grain Beetles (Rusty, Merchant and Saw-toothed), Flour Beetles (Red and Confused), Indian Meal Moths, Cigarette Beetles, Drugstore Beetles, Rice Weevils, Lesser Grain Borers, Spider Beetles and Tobacco Moths:** Treat exposed stages. Remove all food-stuffs, utensils and shell paper from areas to be treated. Discard used shell paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow to dry prior to replacement of shell paper, food and utensils. Wash any exposed food handling surfaces and utensils before use.

**Carpet Beetles (Black, Furniture and Varied):** Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.  
**WoollyBugs Clothes Moths:** Use this product as a crack and crevice treatment in closets and other storage areas where these pests are found. This is an adjunct treatment and will not control moth larvae already on clothes. Do not apply to clothing.  
**Bedbugs (and Lice):** Remove blankets, sheets, etc., and launder these articles before reuse. Lightly spray mattresses, especially tufts, toilet seats, and edges of beds (pillows and headboards) and spray in all joints. Allow to dry before remaking bed. Also treat baseboards, moldings, dresser drawers and frames.

**Flying Insects: Houseflies, gnats, mosquitoes and small flying moths:** Spray localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, inside surfaces of window and door frames, surfaces around light fixtures and cords, railings, etc. and anywhere these insects may rest. Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed.

**Horse Stables: Stable flies, horn flies, house flies, face flies, horse flies, deer flies, mosquitoes and gnats:** Apply thoroughly to surfaces until wet. Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed or repelled. Do not spray animals or humans, or apply to animal feed or watering equipment.

**OUTDOOR APPLICATION:**

Point sprayer away from face. Hold sprayer on a slight downward angle, approximately 12 inches from surface to be sprayed. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. Do not contaminate fish ponds or apply directly to water.

**PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: Ants, cockroaches (including Asian cockroaches), centipedes, clover mites, crickets, mole crickets, sowbugs (pillbugs) and water bugs:** Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area. Also spray legs of tables and chairs.

**Ants:** Spray freely around ant trails and hills. Spray around nests hidden under steels, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris.

**Lone Star Ticks, Dog Ticks, and Fleas:** Apply thoroughly to infestation in bushes, grass or weeds.  
**Wasps, Mud Daubers, Hornets, Yellow Jackets and Bees:** Spray nests and other surfaces where these pests may rest. Aim spray at nest openings. Applications should be made late in the evening when insects are all rest.

**Flying Insects: Houseflies, gnats, mosquitoes and small flying moths:** Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, surfaces around light fixtures and cords, railings, etc. where these insects may rest. Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed.

**Termites, Carpenter Ants, and Carpenter Bees:** (for localized control only) Apply to voids or channels in damaged wood of a structure, or to cracks, crevices and spaces in and between wooden portions of a structure or between wood and the foundation, in locations vulnerable to attack such as crawl spaces. Retreat if needed but not more than once per week. For termites, the purpose of such applications is to kill workers or winged forms which may be present in the treated areas at the time of application. Not recommended as sole protection against termites. For active infestations, get a professional inspection. Such applications are not a substitute for mechanical alteration, soil treatment or foundation treatment but are merely a supplement. For severe termite infestation, contact a professional pest control operator in your area. For carpenter bees, treat directly into the gallery entrance hole. Following treatment the entrance holes may be left open for three days to be certain that returning adult carpenter bees are killed. When there is no activity, the hole may be sealed with a suitable sealant.

**HOUSE PLANTS: Aphids, Japanese beetles, lace bugs, leafminers, mealy bugs, mites and spider mites on house plants:** Prior to spraying, remove plants from living and eating areas. Put plants in an area not likely to come in contact with pets, children or food. Plants can be returned to original location when leaves dry. If plants cannot be moved, cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Avoid spraying surrounding areas. Apply spray to upper and lower surfaces of foliage. Avoid wetting blossoms if possible.
